

Q: My Ash tree looks like it is dying - now what?

A: *Since the discovery of the Emerald Ash Borer in Michigan in 2002 it has killed more than 25 million trees in North America. The borer destroys the tree's ability to store water and nutrients. Evidence of the borer include dying branches at the top of the tree, vertical bark splitting and new branches sprouting from the base of the tree. Systemic insecticides can be used to treat infected trees but once a tree loses 50% of its canopy it is no longer treatable. Depending on the degree of infestation, an ash tree will die within two to five years of being infected. Once an ash tree dies, it does not maintain its structural integrity and should be removed as soon as possible. In addition to being an eyesore in your landscape, a dead ash can drop large limbs and may topple over completely in wind or ice storms, creating major safety and liability issues.*
